#### **Parade Meeting**

• A representative from each entry should attend a virtual meeting to discuss the event details and ask questions. The parade team will schedule this and email all participants, after October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024, with date and meeting link.

#### **Entry Size Limits**

- The entire entry should not exceed 100 feet in length.
- Vehicles must not exceed 50 feet in length, 8 feet in width, or 13.5 feet in height.
- Vehicle wheels should not extend beyond fenders.
- All vehicles and floats need valid driver's license, insurance, and registration.

# **Check-In Requirements**

- Bring proof of:
  - 1. License
  - 2. Registration
  - 3. Insurance

Without these documents, you can't participate

#### **During Check-In, You'll Get**

- An official entry number:
  - 1. Vehicles: Place on the passenger side windshield.
  - 2. Walking groups: Carry at the front of your group.

#### Line Up

- Follow Parade Representative's directions based on your entry number.
- Vehicles must have a driver with keys ready for emergencies.
- Be ready to start at 10:00 AM. Please be patient with volunteers and others.

### **Line-Up Information**

- An official line-up will be emailed before the parade.
- A preliminary line-up will be available at the orientation.
- Use the map included for reference.

#### **De-Staging Guidelines**

Don't block other entries behind you; it affects the parade's flow.

#### **General Information**

- Follow instructions from Parade Representatives on Indian School Road.
- Flaggers will guide you.
- Floats & Vehicles: Don't stop or drop off people within 500 feet of the De-Staging area.
  - 1. Pull over to let traffic pass after dropping off passengers.
  - 2. Exit safely.
  - 3. For complex breakdowns, use side streets off 2nd or 4th Street.
  - 4. Leave the area quickly and safely after the parade.
- Exit the road promptly and follow instructions from Representatives. They will direct you to exit either East or West, please follow directions.

#### Cleanup/Trash

• Each entry is solely responsible for the removal of all items and trash from construction or deconstruction. We are asking you respect the local businesses and please remove all trash or remaining items during and after setup.
